THE PRINCIPAL ELEMENTS OF THE PLAN ARE:

PHASE 1:

The first stage of the plan will see new toilet facilities, new canteen, new shop and fencing around the perimeters. All of these are essential developments to the future growth of the club and its community. It is envisaged that Phase 1 of the plan will be completed within two years and earlier depending on funding.

PHASE 2:

The second phase will see improved facilities for players and members. Dressing Rooms will also be included within this phase along with a gym. Function rooms and games rooms are also envisaged for the youth of the town and the greater community.

• PHASE 3:

The long term vision is for an astro-turf pitch, Walking-track (around the grounds) and further development of the stands.

Planning applications have been submitted to Limerick City & County Council and communications are ongoing.

Funding is being sought from Sports Capital Grants, The Munster Council, players past and present, club members and all involved with the Kilmallock Club and community.



Kilmallock GAA Club was formed in 1884. Our club lies deep at the heart of the association's activities. It has been a focal point for the town and greater area over the last 130 years.

Due to the collective efforts of generations of players, administrators and members the club has created a history steeped in stories of dedication and commitment.
